Detect erroneous trends at an early stage

Get your projects „back-on-track“

Sounds familiar?

- Unclear or conflicting statements about the project objective and project charter
- Multiple postponing deadlines and milestones
- Project management is not able to respond to questions about project planning or project execution issues sufficiently
- Very optimistic reporting (a lot of “yellow” lights, although all parties see the project status to "red")
- Acceptance of the project with key stakeholders (customers, users, etc.) is starting to decline
- Lack of transparency in resource use in the project (budget consumption, investment, project work) or substantial budget overrun

Project Health Check

- A Project Health Check is a short assessment of a project
- Used when a project threatens to fall into difficulties or has already fallen
- Can be done proactively to increase the probability of success
- Checks the state of the project based on internationally recognized best practices / standards for the project management (PMBOK®, PRINCE2®) and gives instructions on how to improve your project
- Takes usually 3 - to 4 days and is performed at your site
- Can be used at any time during the project

Benefits

- Transparency - Rapid and compact insight in the project and its weaknesses
- An independent view on the project offers a neutral view on the true state of the project
- Derivation of concrete measures for improvement and quick wins from the assessment results
- Threat of bad investments can be averted or mitigated considerably if a Project Health Check carried out on time and then the corrective measures will be implemented resolved
- The Project Health Check can serve as an initiation for the optimization of future project work

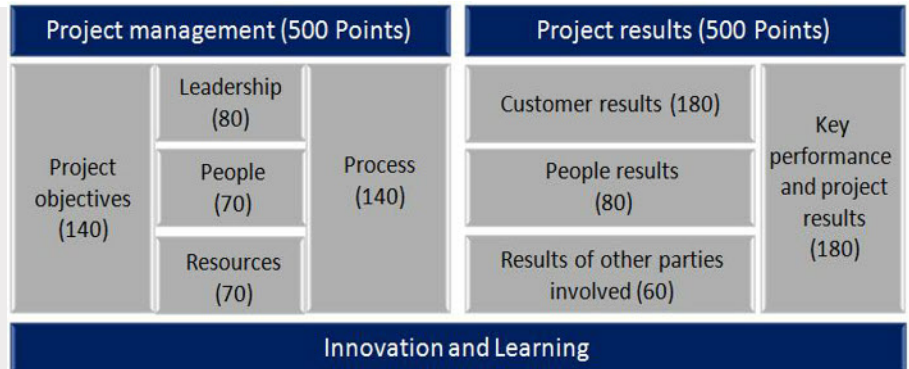

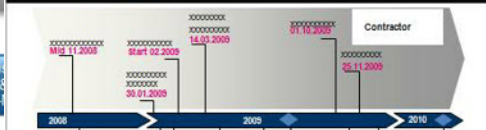
Key findings of a Project Health Check

- Qualified and prioritized recommendations for solving the issues to get the project back on course

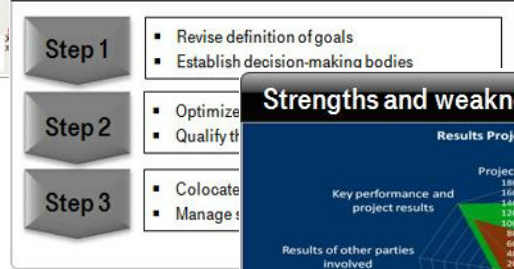
